R ESEARCH **S** OURCES

The HEART OF TEXAS RECORDS published by the Central Texas Genealogical Society, Inc. (Waco) Volume XXIII, Winter 1980, Number 4, has an article that our members should be aware of. This is one of the publications that we exchange with, so the issue referred to is in the Bryan Library. The article is on pp. 117-120 and is titled County Maps, How to Order From Thirteen Southern States. The article gives the maps that are available, cost, shipping information, and where to write to order them.

County maps are such fun when a specific county is identified with a family. Even old communities that no longer have a post office will be pinpointed on county maps, and all the little rural cemeteries are shown. There are also all the little streams and creeks with names that will help in identifying land descriptions. The states listed are Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia.

For those of you who are saying, 'Why wasn't my state listed?' Write to the highway department in the state capitol of the state you need and ask for their order form or information. These are available in most states and are not expensive. Good hunting!

Alphabetically by last name of deceased. Indexed.

GNL PAIGE. List of Freemen of Massachusetts, 1630-1691. 974.4 Under the first charter of the Massachusetts Colony, none were regarded as freemen, or members of the body politic, except those who were admitted by the General Court and took the oath of allegiance to the established government. Listed by date, then order of registration. Indexed.

GNL Washington County, Rhode Island, Births 1770 to 1850. 974.5 For the towns of: North Kingstown, South Kingstown, Exeter, Westerly, Charlestown, Richmond, and Hopkinton. Compiled from original records. Alphabetically by last name, then first, date of birth, then code for town. Read Introduction!

GNL Settlers of Rensselaerswyck, 1630-1658. Arrival and Occupation of the settlers in the New York Colony from its founding to the end of the administration of Jan Baptist van RENNELAER. Settlers of Norwegian, German and Dutch origin. 974.7

GNL Pennsylvania German Immigrants, 1709-1786. Lists consolidated 974.8 from the yearbooks of the Pennsylvania German Folklore Society. Immigrants from: Wuerttemberg, Wertheim, Zweibruecken and Scheffhausen. Index by personal name and by name of ships.

Concerns the Mero District of North Carolina which in 1796 became part of the new state of Tennessee. Includes family histories, land grants issued by North Carolina, officers in the militia, pensioners, overseers of roads and Methodists in Middle Tennessee. Indexed.

GENEALOGICAL RESEARCH AT A&M

Here is another installment of the library information from Bill PAGE, library Assistant at the A&M University Library. ADVERTISER II-1, pp. 18-20 has information about the card catalog, how to use it, what to look for, etc, and indexes and bibliographies that will be useful. ADVERTISER II-2, pp. 25-27 began the listing by state and code for finding the general books on that subject, (Alabama through Louisiana). ADVERTISER II-3, pp. 53-55 has Maine through part of North Carolina. Here are the rest of the state listings. Don't forget--ask one of the library assistants to show you were to find a listed book if their index does not make it clear!
